Invitation to Genesis is a 10 session study. To Live Is Christ by Beth Moore is a 10 session study on the life and heart of Paul, the Apostle. There are other small group studies available on John, Romans, Psalms and other books of the Bible, plus more general studies on spiritual formation, growth, and service.
